[33] But **seek** ye **first** the kingdom of God, **and** his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

(Seek) **Matthew 7:7** A.S.K.
(1st Kingdom) **Mark 4**
(1st Righteousness) **Psalm 119:172 | Deuteronomy 6:25**

(Seek) **Matthew 7:7**

[7] Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

A.S.K.

ASK and you **receive** by faith but it's not visible yet

SEEK and you will **find**, what you have received by faith

KNOCK and you will **possess**, what you have received by faith



(Seek 1st Kingdom) Mark 4

[11] And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the **mystery** of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: [13] And he said unto them, Know ye not **this** parable? and how then will ye know all parables? **Mark 4:11,13**

Jesus mentions the 'Kingdom of God'
54 times throughout the 4 gospels!

Mark 4:26-29

[26] And he said, So is the **kingdom of God**, as if a man should cast **seed** into the **ground**; (**Luke 8:11** | seed is word) (**Mark 4:15** | the word that was sown in their hearts)

[27] And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed (**word**) should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. [28] For **the earth** bringeth forth fruit (manifestation of word seed)... of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

2 Timothy 3:16

[16] All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for **instruction in righteousness**:

Seek 1st God's Promises and the Instructions/conditions for those promises to be fulfilled (pertaining to the things you need!)

e.g. If you want **Joy** in your life

Psalm 16:11 | Thou wilt shew me the path of life: **in thy presence** is **fulness** of **joy**; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Psalm 22:3 | But thou art holy, O thou that **inhabitest** the **praises** of Israel.

If someone inhabits something, then their presence is there. So therefore if you want joy and it can be found in God's presence then if you praise God you will have His presence and fulness of Joy comes with it.

Philippians 4:4 | **Rejoice** in the Lord **always**: and again I say, **Rejoice**.

1 Thessalonians 5:16 | Rejoice evermore

Psalm 34:1 | I will bless the LORD at all times: his **praise** shall **continually** be in my mouth.



You can do the Same thing for anything else
(Marriage/career/fear/addiction/finance/health/mental health)

2 Peter 1:3

[3] According as his divine power hath given unto us **all things** that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

Deuteronomy 4:5-6,9

[5] Behold, I have **taught you statutes and judgments**, even as the Lord my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

[6] Keep therefore and **do** them ; for **this is your wisdom** and your **understanding** in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people. [9] Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they **depart from thy heart** all the days of thy life: but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;

The Truth About God's Commandments

1 John 5:3

[3] For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are **not grievous**.

John 15:10-11

These things have I spoken unto you, that **my joy might remain in you**, and that your **joy might be full**. (The more I obey the more full my joy is!)

John 10:10

[10] The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.



(Seek 1st Righteousness)

Psalm 119:172

[172] My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy **commandments** are righteousness.

Deuteronomy 6:25

[25] And it shall be **our** righteousness, if we observe to **do** all these commandments before the Lord our God, as he hath commanded us.

James 1:22-25

[22] But be ye doers of the word, and not **hearers only**, deceiving your own selves.

[23] For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

[24] For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

[25] But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he **being not a forgetful hearer**, but a doer of the work, **this man** shall be blessed in his deed.

Faith without works is dead nothing just falls in your lap!

Jesus said Seek Ye **1st** | Not Seek Ye **Only**

Yes put the kingdom 1st... However, you need corresponding action to the objectives I wanted to achieve A.S.K. (being a **doer** of the word) and God's Watches over His Promises and when we Obey He performs 100% of the time.



Conclusion | How To Have All Things ADDED!!

Matthew 6:33 [33] But **seek** ye **first** the kingdom of God, **and** his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

1. Seek First **Kingdom** (Seed Word Instruction/Promises for situation) (Ground Heart)
2. Seek First (**righteousness**) obey it (our Righteousness) Prioritise Agenda

3. God Does The Adding | Stop Worrying
1 Peter 5:6-7 [6] Humble yourselves therefore under the **mighty hand** of God, that he may exalt you in due time: [7] Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you. (Sermon: God What Are You Doing?)

Matthew 6:26-28,31-34

[26] Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? [27] Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? [28] And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: [31] Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? [32] (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. [33] But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. [34] Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Psalms 84:11

[11] For the Lord God is a sun and shield: the Lord will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Job 36:11

[11] If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.
